

DGAC Anti-Trust Do's and Don'ts

DO:

Study the DGAC statement regarding Anti-Trust which is posted on the DGAC website,

Observe Anti-Trust guidelines for all business and personal conversations,

Stop someone from violating the Anti-Trust guidelines,

Leave a conversation if Anti-Trust guidelines are neglected. Do not listen and remain silent.

Do Not:

Talk about prices, profits, pricing, proposals or policies,

Talk or offer any aid which could be viewed as restraining trade or unfair competition,

Have any conversation or take any action that could be in violation of the law.
